Food Insecurity Announcement

A Letter from President Scott and the Dollisons



We want to thank each of our donors and supporters for helping with establishing the Larry Dollison Endowment Fund to address the food desert/ insecurity problem in Whately.

When we asked people to contribute in lieu of flowers to this fund, we didn't anticipate the overwhelming response we received. We are so pleased to announce that at this time, the fund has exceeded \$13,000!

Originally our plan for this money was to start a food co-op in the Whately area, but after learning that it would take 2-5 years, \$500,000 to \$1 million, and that over 90% of co-ops are for-profit, we have decided that we will instead use the funds to establish a new and different kind of grocery store/ food pantry to address immediate food needs in this area.

We're happy to let you know that the WCC board of directors will serve as the fiscal agent for this grocery/ food pantry and that we are getting the ball rolling on this project immediately. Our primary concern is to address this issue and help people to help themselves. Please know that this will not be a traditional food pantry, and that it will be beneficial to everyone in this neighborhood, regardless of income level. We will provide more information as this project develops, and we are very excited about how it will impact this wonderful community. We invite all interested and passionate people to join us in this effort.

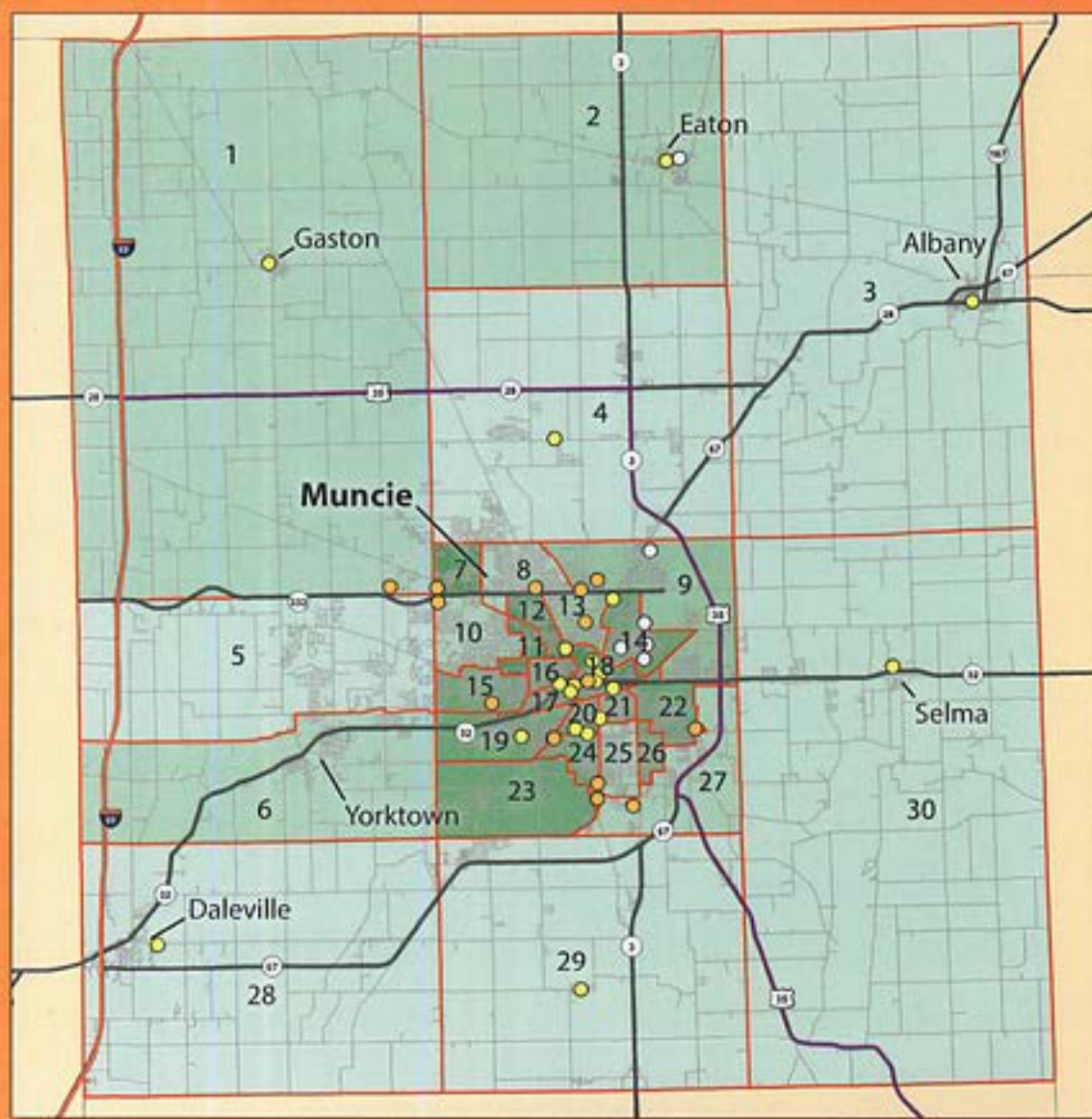
